The current roof is metal and it will be replaced by a metal roof. It was suggested that due to pitch that Mr. Painchard should confirm with contractor that the seams will be set mechanically and not by hand. A motion was made by Jon Davis and seconded by Matt Weismantel to recommend approval for this replacement room. The motion was passed unanimously.
- Vince Pocino offered a detailed update of the renovation of 5 Chesterfield-Crosswicks Road (Blacksmith Shop). The detailed information and presentation binder was most appreciated by the HPC members. A motion was made by Matt Weismantel and seconded by Jon Davis to recommend approval of this project by the Planning Board. The motion was passed unanimously.
