WHEREAS, the Tax Assessor has reviewed and approved the Veteran Exemption effective October 4, 2023; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of the Township of Chesterfield, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, hereby approves the veteran exemption on Block 700 Lot 5 effective October 4, 2023 and thereafter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tax Collector is hereby authorized to cancel 2023 taxes in the amount of \$2,741.52 and 2024 preliminary taxes billed in the amount of \$5,665.90.
