**RESOLUTION TO CANCEL TAXES DUE TO VETERAN EXEMPTION
FOR 45 WHITE PINE ROAD KNOWN AS BLOCK 600 LOT 40**

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30A allows for the exemption from taxation from real and personal property for any citizen and resident of the State who has a total or 100% permanent disability as defined by this statute; and

WHEREAS, James & Valerie Walts own the property located at 45 White Pine Road known as Block 600 Lot 40 and recorded in deed dated June 29, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Valerie Walts is a 100% disabled Veteran; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Walts has completed form D.V.S.S.E. and provided the documentary proofs required to the Tax Assessor; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Assessor has reviewed and approved the Veteran Exemption effective August 5, 2024; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of the Township of Chesterfield, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, hereby approves the veteran exemption on Block 600 Lot 40 effective August 5, 2024 and thereafter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tax Collector is hereby authorized to cancel taxes in the amount of \$6,605.92.
